Dear Mr. Turzak:

A permit is hereby granted by the City of Chicago Department of Environment to Innovative Technology and Materials, Inc. ("the Permittee") to operate a waste handling facility located within the corporate limits of the City of Chicago at 10823 S. Langley Ave. ("the Facility"). Incorporated into this permit by reference are the following: 1) the application received April 9, 2001, including drawings, sheets and specifications; and 2) all other supplemental information submitted as part of this application.

The Permittee shall fully comply with the Standard Conditions of this permit set forth in Attachment A and the Special Conditions of this permit set forth in Attachment B.

This permit allows for the operation of the Facility from July 26, 2001 through July 25, 2002 upon which time the permit shall terminate by its own terms. On or before July 25, 2002, the Permittee may apply to the Department of Environment for a new operating permit for the following year. If a subsequent operating permit is applied for on or before July 25, 2002, this permit shall remain in effect until the Department of Environment acts on the subsequent permit application.
